

ASCT TRUSTEE RECRUITMENT



ASCT is a registered Charitable Trust and is looking to recruit additional Trustees to serve the aims and objectives of the organisation and to help shape its future.

ASCT exists to offer care and provide education to deprived Children in the Philippines. ASCT does this through three projects:

Mango Tree House

Residential care is provided at Mango Tree House, a family-style home for up to 35 Children who have been abandoned, neglected or abused. All go to school or college locally and can remain at Mango until they have completed their education at whatever level.

Grapevine

Through our Grapevine project we offer family support and provide education for children in families whose financial situation means that the children would otherwise have to work rather than attend school.

Cashew Tree School

Cashew Tree School provides pre-school education for 150 4-6 year olds. This purpose built school provides high quality education for the poorest children from the most disadvantaged families.

ASCT passionately believe in the rights of every child to be educated, enabling them to develop skills and abilities so that they can become responsible, independent adults in their communities.

To assist in the successful implementation of these goals the ASCT Board of Trustees has identified the need to supplement the board with additional members who can bring additional key skills and enthusiasm and in particular:

- **Further skills to improve efficiency and effectiveness.** This includes the 'hard' skills particularly legal knowledge, marketing and general business management. However, equally important are the 'soft' skills: encouraging team working, problem solving, facilitating decision making and maintaining good working relationships with ASCT.
- **Time and energy to oversee and support the development of the charity's work and staff.**

ASCT is a Christian organisation with a Christian ethos amongst the current board. Our care and support is not however limited to those who are

Christian. New board members will need to be sympathetic and engage with the aims and ethos of the organisation.

Process

- If both parties are keen to proceed you will be invited to attend a trustees meeting.
- Applications will be considered by the board
